

**60 Point PowerPoint:
YOUR CHOICE. The Rubric
Below Identifies What to
Include and How Many
Points Each Detail is Worth**



1. Choose an appropriate **Middle School Topic**:**5 points**
2. **Create 10 slides** for your topic **USING A PowerPoint THEME OR TEMPLATE**:**10 points**
3. **First slide**, Title Slide, identifies **topic and YOUR NAME with no picture****5 points**
4. After Title slide, **at least 7 of the other slides have TITLES with at least 3 bulleted points THAT ARE NOT SENTENCES OR PARAGRAPHS**. *Text in PowerPoint should be SHORT BURSTS and NOT big blocks of reading***10 points**
5. Use a **picture on all slides EXCEPT ON THE TITLE SLIDE**. **TWO** slides can be all picture(s). At least 9 pictures total**10 points**
6. **ALL PICTURES need to relate to your topic****5 points**
7. **There are Transitions** (how slides move in) on all slides**10 points**
8. **All bullet points & NOT slide titles have animation** (You may use ALL AT ONCE. These animations do not need to be by paragraph/bullet points).....**5 points**

IMPORTANT NOTE: *Slideshows and videos are NOT good formats to expect people to read more than BRIEF BURSTS of text. When we want share more text than brief text statements, USE A PRINT FORMAT INSTEAD OF A SLIDE SHOW.*
