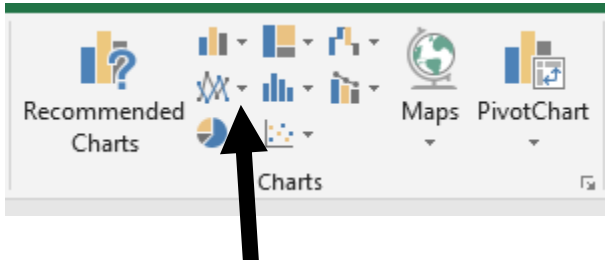


## Excel Charting: Widget Line Chart

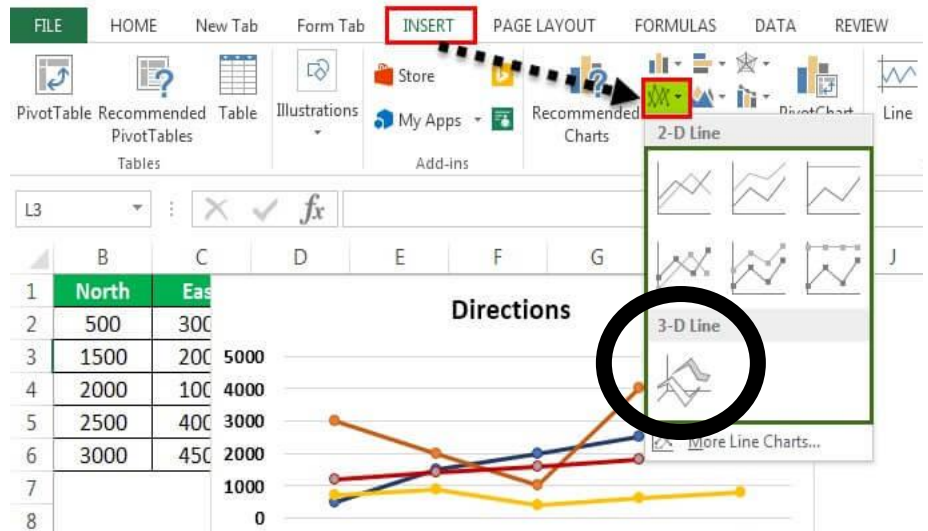
- Using your WORKBOOK charts 1, highlight the range A1:C14 as shown right
- On the INSERT RIBBON, locate the CHARTS options (Below)

- Click on LINE CHARTS. **Ignore all the 2-D ones** (There are 5 choices).
- SELECT THE 3-D OPTION IN THE SECOND GROUPING of choices.

- Click on the text box for CHART TITLE for the Line Chart/Graph. **Title it: Widget Line Chart**
