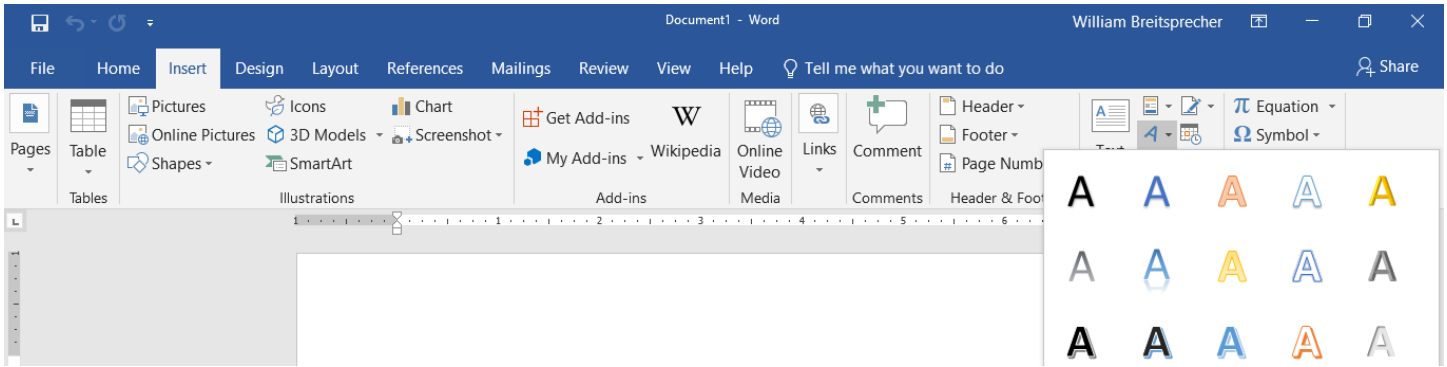
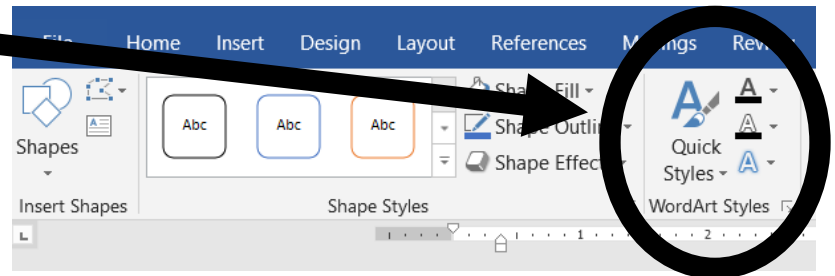


Fun with Microsoft Word's WordArt



1. WordArt is a way to create colorful text that pops off a page. Above is how you access the WordArt Gallery (INSERT – INSERT WORD ART pull-down menu,
2. You can choose the basic styles from the options shown ABOVE, RIGHT.
3. WordArt is NOT SPELL CHECKED! Some prefer to key text first (text is spell checked), highlight that text, and apply WordArt. You may just INSERT WORDART and then enter text in YOUR TEXT HERE box.

4. There Quick Styles for WordArt.
 - a. Text fill (top)
 - b. Text fill (middle)
 - c. Text Effects (bottom)



5. When placing text over a picture, it may be best to use WordArt and use the style options to make sure the text stands-out against that picture.
6. One way to do this is to use a LIGHT TEXT FILL, a DARK CONTRASTING OUTLINE BIG ENOUGH TO CLEARLY SHOW LETTERS (but not too big!), and then a GLOW EFFECT to create some color around the outline.
7. Best way to learn WordArt is to EXPERIMENT and ask others if they can read your text.
